



# Marin County Emergency Rental Assistance Program

## Do you need help paying for rent between September 2020 and January 2021?

The County's Emergency Rental Assistance Program is currently open and accepting applicants. In order to apply for and receive assistance, please do the following:



**Step 1:** Call **415-473-2223** to be added to the waitlist. If your call is not answered, please leave a message with your name and callback number so a member of our staff can contact you.



**Step 2:** Our staff will reach out to you to ask some intake questions.



**Step 3:** Once the intake is complete, you will need to send the following documents before we can move forward with assistance:

- Copy of photo ID with a Marin County address (if your ID doesn't have a Marin County address, you will need to send a copy of a photo ID with a utility bill/other bill that shows your Marin County address)
- Proof of Income (pay stub, bank statement)
- Copy of the first page of your rental lease, or other proof of residency

*\*Note: if you can't get some of this documentation, we are willing to work with you to show your financial situation in other ways.*

*\*Note: this program is open to all Marin residents regardless of citizenship status.*
